GWMWater

Background

- 2013 RCC introduced to support subsidies for water supplied to nominated recreation lakes and discounts to sporting clubs in the 2013 Water Price Review
- 2018 discounts extended to schools following further consultation for the 2018 Water Price Review
- 2023 Community Panel supported GWMWater's proposal to retain the current RCC however requested GWMWater explore applying the RCC to commercial customers as well



Recreation Water Pricing Policy

- Volumetric rate discounts to recreational and sporting organisations funded through a recreation contribution charge of \$20.48 per residential customer; \$10.24 for concession card holders.
- Urban and Rural Volumetric Rate Discounts eligible sporting clubs, services clubs and schools
 - Consumption up to 5 ML per annum 40% discounted volumetric rate
 - Consumption between 5 to 10 ML 25% discounted volumetric rate
 - Consumption greater than 10 ML would be charged at the full volumetric rate
- 3. Recreation Lake Water subsidised at \$28.22 / ML





Value of discounts to Recreational and Sporting Clubs \$410,000


Recreation Lake Volume Supplied - 2,510 ML
